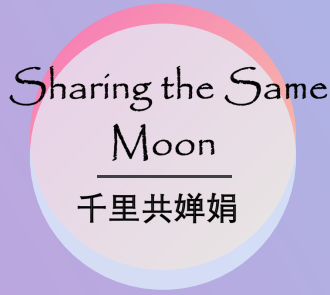

The exhibition is divided into two groups, the senior painter group and the young artist group.

Senior Artists Group:

There will be an exhibition of contemporary art and Australian aboriginal art being represented by Australian artists. Classical art focusing on cross cultural art which is covered by Japan, China, Korean, Taiwan Artists. Works by senior artists will then be bought and sold with a commission partnership component.

Young Artists Group:

The main focus is on individual creativity to showcase their basic skills and the sense of mind.

Through the exhibition "Sharing the SameMoon", we sincerely look forward to your participation, and hope to bring together, through art, the sharing of culture, happiness and friendship between Western and Eastern. Through this exhibition we hope to integrate art into the development of the commercial sector and to achieve charitable donations, all of which will be donated to charitable organisations in the future.

Promising Artists Group:

The AFA ArtAcademy holds an annual exhibition and competition for young painters. We need to select 60 paintings out of the 200 entries, out of which 60 paintings will be awarded a certificate of merit and the finalists will be published in a book and on the website

Out of the 60 paintings, 10 will be selected as the finalists and awarded prizes and certificates, with the winner receiving AUD\$1,000.00, the first runner-up AUD\$800.00, the second runner-up AUD\$600.00, the merit award AUD\$400.00, the creativity award AUD\$400.00 and five consolation prizes of AUD\$200.00. A medal will also be awarded along with the prize money. (Only applied in young artists aged 18 and over)

Promising Artists: one work per person, 25 dollars for one work registration fee, W*H should not be over 1sq meters, based on the theme of the exhibition, in photo format(for printing), with your name and age in the entry, schoolname, material, size and description in the email. 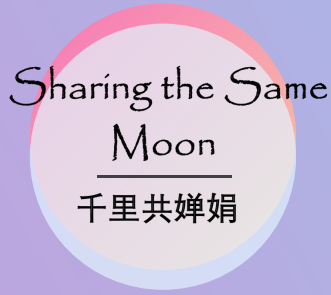
